

ALLOWING RECORDS

Too many "fast" records are allowed. There seems to be a race on even among the various state high school associations to see which can publish the best records. Wind and other favorable conditions are disregarded and the committees allow records unjustly. Watches are borrowed from coaches and without any regulation whatever are put in the hands of inexperienced timers, with the result that many new district, regional, and even state records are unjustly recorded.

LIMITING COMPETITION

Several state associations are limiting the number of events a boy may enter, and particular attention is given to the long distance races. The most nearly general rule limits a boy to one race of 440 yards or more, and perhaps one relay in addition. The writer has investigated the rules of several states and has found that there is an apparent regulation along this line which is not real. For instance, the boys are limited strictly in the number of events they may enter in the final state championship meets, but there are no regulations as far as their preliminary meets are concerned. The damage is already done when the boys get to the state meet, and the regulation there is of little value. Boys should be more carefully guarded in preliminary meets than in final championship events.

RULES CHANGES

There are some very important rules changes reported in the Guide this year. Last year the proper method of staggering lanes was explained, but owing to an adopted change in the number of inches a runner is allowed from the pole, these specifications are altered in this year's Guide. Balk lines are discontinued and legal jumps explained. Other important alterations will be found in the 1932 Guide.
