Lowell's leading light, Jim Plessas, established his second city record in two days yesterday at Kezar Stadium during unlimited field trials for Saturday's city prep track and field meet.

The Indian star leaped 23 feet, 10 inches to pace the broad jump qualifiers. Old record was 23 feet, 5 inches, made last year by Dick Hare of Washington. Tues day Plessas raced the 180 yard low hurdles in a record 19.2. yard

After the second day of trials, Balboa had placed the most men in the finals. Nine Bucs had secured eleven places. Defending Champion Lowell had placed eight men in eight places, Poly seven in nine, Lincoln seven in eight, Washington and St. Ignatius each five in six, Galileo and Mission each four in four and Commerce three in five.

Classy Jim Plessas of Lowell High yesterday bettered the California interscholastic low hurdle record and established a new San Francisco prep mark in the bargain.

Plessas, Lowell student body president, skipped over the 180 yard low hurdles in 19.2 seconds in the City Meet trials at Kezar Stadium. The State record is State record lugh McElhenny, Stadium. The State record is :19.3, set by Hugh McElhenny, the celebrated Compton JC grid flash, when he was at Washington High, Los Angeles, in 1947. State records must be set in the annual meet.

The old Academic Athletic Association standard was :20.5, established by Lowell's Loren Baker last year.

Plessas had a tail wind of undetermined velocity. Wind gauges are not provided at San Francisco prep meets.
