

Lowell Nabs Track Relays

HOLLISTER, May 4. — Lowell High School of San Francisco won the nineteenth annual Hollister Invitational track meet last night, racking up 45 points as Phil Fehlen broke a meet record in the high jump.

Fehlen leaped six feet to top the invitational record of five feet, eleven inches set in 1949. Lowell also set a new relay record in the broad jump. The four-man team's aggregate total hit a mark of 78 feet, eleven and a half inches.

Dick Guthrie's 21 feet, one and a half inches performance topped that of his three running mates, Herb Yim, Bob Carlson and Bob Yamabi.

Salinas placed second in the A Division team total with 39½ points. Hometown Hollister was third with 34½ markers.

St. Ignatius placed last in the A Division when only half of the Wildcat team arrived in time to compete—the team bus broke down part way to Hollister.
