

# Alameda High Track Team Sets Records

Unexpectedly crowned champions of the North Coast Section of the CIF on Saturday afternoon at Edwards Field in Berkeley, the five-man Alameda high school track and field team is anxiously looking ahead to the California state championship meet in Los Angeles Coliseum.

Given only an outside chance to win the North Coast, Coach Lewis Jolley's boys surprised by breaking two records and equalling a third to pile up 37 points against a strong field.

## TWO RECORDS SET

Herb Turner, the Hornet sprint star, was the backbone of the team effort as he broke his own 220 yards mark with a :21.4 to shave three-tenths of a second off the previous best, tied the 17-year-old 100-yard dash record of George Frick, and then ran the anchor lap with the Alameda 88-yard relay team set a new record of 1:30.4 in the morning.

However, the surprise element that started the Hornets victory bound was the second place points captured by Hosea Harper in the 440, and the 4:32.9 mile, which is the fastest this year in Northern California prepdom, by Parnell Thomas.

Turner along with Harper, James Jackson, and Leotus Hunter broke the old record of 1:30.7, which was set by a Jolley-coached team back in 1935.
