

Records Tumble As Santa Rosa Tops Qualifying

PETALUMA, May 9—Santa Rosa Panthers copped six first places, including four record-breaking performances today to dominate the Division Three track and field qualifying for next Saturday's North Coast Section finals at Berkeley.

In all, seven records fell by the wayside. They are: Santa Rosa's Larry Robbins in both hurdles; Santa Rosa's Paul Litza and Vernon Borbe in the discus and half mile, respectively; Drake's Walt Langford in the 100- and 440-yard dashes, and Healdsburg's Jim Sarzoti in the 220-yard dash. Sarzoti also won the broad jump.

Borbe's 2:04.0 in the 880, shaved four and two-fifths seconds off the old mark for the meet's most impressive record-breaker. The first three places in each event qualified for next Saturday's finals. Today's scoring included: Santa Rosa 66, Drake 44, Healdsburg 23, Vallejo 21 $\frac{3}{4}$, Petaluma 18 $\frac{1}{4}$, Benicia 17 $\frac{3}{4}$, Napa 13, Sonoma 10 $\frac{1}{4}$, Hoopa 6, Analy 6, Arcarta 5, Ukiah 5, Ferndale 5, Tamalapais 2 and Fort Bragg 2. San Rafael, Tomales and St. Helena did not score.

Santa Rosa Panthers Win

PETALUMA, May 9.—Santa Rosa's Panthers accounted for four of seven records broken today as track and field athletes from eighteen schools in Division Three, North Coast Section, qualified for next Saturday's NCS finals at Berkeley.

New records were set by Santa Rosa's Larry Robbins in both hurdles events, Drake's Walt Langford in the 100 and 440, Santa Rosa's Paul Litza in the discus, Vernon Borbe in the half mile and Healdsburg's Jim Sarzotti in the 220.

The first three men in each event qualified for the NCS meet.

Santa Rosa, the North Bay League champ, won five first places. The Panthers ran up 66 points, followed in order by:

Drake (D), 44; Healdsburg (Healds), 23; Vallejo (V), 21½; Petaluma (P), 18¾; Benicia (Ben), 17¾; Napa (N), 13; Sonoma (Son), 10¼; Hoopa (Hoop), 6; Anay (An), 6; Arcata (Arc), 5; Ukiah (Uk), 5; Ferndale (Fern), 5; Tamalpais (Tam), 2, and Fort Bragg (Ft. B.), 2. San Rafael, Tomales and St. Helena failed to score.

Greatest performance in the record breaking splurge was Borbe's 2:04 in the half mile,

which smashed the old mark by four and two tenths seconds.
