Preps Break 10 Marks

MARTINEZ, April 24.—Tall, bespectacled Dick Dailey, Hayward High junior, high jumped 6 feet 7 inches in the thirteenth annual Martinez Relays today.

The East Bay whiz thus hit the highest mark recorded in prepdom this year. He came within a whisker of wiping out the national interscholastic standard set by Bill LaCava back in the 1930s. This mark—6-7 $\frac{3}{8}$ —Dailey missed by the narrowest of margins at 6-7 $\frac{5}{8}$.

This was the climax of a record assault unprecedented in this meet. In all, ten marks were set in the twelve events for Class A schools, and seven in the twelve events for the smaller or Class B schools.

TWO NEW MARKS.

Monte Upshaw and his Piedmont High crew accounted for two new marks, as did Alameda High's powerful team.

San Francisco got into the record act, too, when Dick Bullock anchored Lowell's high hurdle contingent to a 1:04.7 clocking in the 480 yard shuttle barrier event and Don Robinson anchored Washington's two mile quartet to an 8:17.9 performance.

Until Dailey took charge long after the events were completed, the name on virtually all lips was that of Upshaw. Monte broad jumped 23-2 in a poor pit to boost the Highlanders to a four man aggregate record of 83 feet 1 inch and ran a terrific :12.8 lap to give his team a new shuttle low hurdle relay of :56 flat.

Jumps 6-7

At Martinez

MARTINEZ, April 24—Hayward's Dick Dailey high jumped 6 feet 7 inches today, just $\frac{1}{8}$ of an inch below the National Interscholastic Record in the 13th annual Martinez relays.

Alameda scored $17\frac{1}{2}$ points to take the team title in the large schools division as Richmond got 13, Acalanes 12 and El Cerrito, George Washington Mt. Diablo and Piedmont each scored 11.

Alhambra won the small school division with $26\frac{1}{2}$ points, followed by Antioch with 24 and San Ramon at 20.

Dailey's performance was easily the best California prep effort of the season. The Hayward jumper had the previous topper of 6-5 1-16th.

Every large school record except the discus and pole vault were shattered.

Washington's two-mile relay team of Ron Anderson, Jim Watson, Bill Collins and Don Robinson, set an outstanding mark of 8:17.9, lowering the old standard of 8:27.2. Lowell's 480-yard shuttle relay team of John Vannucci, Bob Zweiss, Stuart Gould and Duck Bullock ran the distance in 1:04.7, against the old mark of 1:05.6.
