

# SI's Tommy Colton Sets 130's Pole Vault Mark

Another St. Ignatius competitor, Tommy Colton, set a 130 exponent record in the pole vault by clearing 11-6¼.

Washington came out of the varsity trials the best numerically, qualifying 14 for the semifinals and six directly into the finals. Balboa was next, 14 and four, and defending champion Poly checked in with 14 and three. In addition, relay teams for every school but Galileo and Mission gained the final.

The other schools fared as follows: Lincoln, seven and one; Lowell, three and three; St. Ignatius four and one; Mission, four and one, and Galileo, one and zero.

Trials continue today, with lightweight track and varsity field events on the schedule. Semifinals will be held tomorrow and the finals Saturday.

# Poly's Gasper, Tillman Set New City High Jump Mark With 6-3 1/2 Leaps

Lightning hit the same spot—the varsity high jumping pit—twice yesterday as Polytechnic's Wilfred Gasper and Jackie Tillman both leaped 6 feet 3 1/2 inches to break the Academic Athletic Association record. The old mark of 6-3 1/4 was set in 1954 by Leroy Thomas of Mission.

Poly's leapers, a 140 10 1/4 discus throw by Lincoln's Mike Lewis and a 23-foot 2-inch broad jump — third best in city prep history—by Washington's Gaynell McPherson featured qualifying trials at Kezar for Saturday's All-City meet. It was the best jump of McPherson's life.

The broad jump, shot put and discus marks will stand up for the finals.

Competition was held yesterday in varsity field events and 130's and 120's running events. Semifinals are scheduled today at Kezar in running events for all three classes.

Gasper, a senior, defending champion in both the high jump and pole vault, had been a strong favorite in the event. After two misses he cleared the record height easily on

the third try for the best jump of his life.

Tillman, a 17-year-old junior whose previous best was 6-1, also missed his first two tries. Most observers thought he was making the attempt for the exercise. But he soared over on the third shot. Gasper missed three times at 6-4 1/2 after Tillman had dropped out because of a muscle cramp. The records will stand, but the jumping competition starts over on Saturday.
