At Santa Rosa

SANTA ROSA, May 19.—Riordan High's Crusaders of San Francisco, paced by Bob Roper's victories in the 100 and 220, won the team title of the North Coast Section Division III meet here today with 35 points while North Bay League champion Drake placed second with 30.

Only other double winner was Sonoma hurdler Jim Sweet, who won the 120 highs in 15.1 and set one of six meet records in the 180 lows in the time of 19.9. Other records:

Jerry Winter of Eureka in the shot (52-7½), Jerry Siebert of Willets in the 880 (1:57.3), Jim Bayles of Vallejo in the discus (130½), Al Hautala of Fort Bragg in the mile (4:33.0) and Willie Hector of Tamalpais in the high jump (6-1).

First five places in each event qualified for next Saturday's championships at Berkeley.

Riordan's Bob Roper took both sprints to lead the San Francisco team and Jerry White added the other victory in the 440. Sonoma's Jim Sweet was also a double winner as he took both the high and lo whurdles. Six records were broken as Riordan scored 35 points to edge second place Drake, which had 30.

The first five finishers in this meet, the Section Two meet yesterday at Salinas and Friday's Section One meet at San Lorenzo will compete in the North Coast championships at Berkeley Saturday.
