

Fastest Prep Time in Lows

REDWOD CITY, April 29.

—Gary Gaskill of Carlmont turned in the fastest prep time in the Nation to date with an 18.9 clocking in the 180 yard low hurdles to highlight the Sequoia High School district track meet today.

Dave Kamrar, a teammate of Gaskill's, raced to a 4:24.7 mile, the fastest in the Northern California this year.
