

# Palo Alto defeats Cubberley

Palo Alto High School swept all but two first places in beating Cubberley 83-30 in the city championship track and field meet at Palo Alto Friday.

The only winners for the Cougars were Bob Kentera in the high jump and the relay team.

Rick Bernstein was the outstanding performer for Palo Alto. He won the high and low hurdles

in the very good times of 15.4 and 20.8.

He set a meet record with a leap of 21-11½ in the broad jump.

Brian Bauer was a double winner for Palo Alto in the 440-yard dash and the half mile.

The best event from a performance standpoint probably was the pole vault.

The Bardsley twins — George

and Dave — and Dick Barkley all tied for first place at 13 feet.

It may be the first time in prep track history that three vaulters from the same school cleared that height in the same meet.

Palo Alto also won the Class B meet. The score was 65-48. Cubberley averted a complete shut-out with a 43-19 in Class C.

The varsity win was the second straight for Palo Alto over Cubberley.

Palo Alto leads the series 5-2 in varsity competition. In Class B Palo Alto recorded its first win. Fred Morse of Cubberley produced the top mark with 50-6¼ effort in the shot put.

The Class B pole vault was won by Bill Wohlschlag of Palo Alto at 11-5¼ for a meet record.
