

# California Repeats in 23rd Annual Track Meet

SINCE 1947 the Athletic Journal has presented annually a "National Track Meet" by comparing the results of the various state meets for the previous spring. In the true sense, this cannot be considered a track meet because the National Federation prohibits any national contests, and too many variables such as weather, temperature, wind, and track facilities would make any comparison on a one-year basis invalid.

Points are awarded on a 10-8-6-4-2-1 basis. On the accompanying chart a star indicates a new state record. A solid red block is used for the winning performance and a red diagonal block is used when two or more states are tied. The points appear in the upper left-hand corner of the appropriate box. The total column shows the total number of points earned by the states, and in color the rank is indicated.

California was the winner again with Texas second. California has now won twenty-one of twenty-three meets. Both states, however, accumulated fewer points than last year. The difference was 43½ points compared to a difference of 47 points last year.

New York moved into third place from seventeenth. Florida went from twenty-second to fourth. Six states, California, Texas, Ohio, Kansas, Arkansas, and Indiana repeated their standing of being in the top ten.

The number of times a state ranks in the first ten over a twenty-three year period is an indication of that state's prowess in track and field. California and Texas never failed to be in the select group. In fact, California has never finished below second place. The following table shows the number of times a state has finished tenth or better.

There were a number of changes in rank from last year. Maryland went from thirty-ninth to thirty-first place. Idaho improved its position by three places, while West Virginia, Nevada,

and Georgia dropped three positions. Florida and Arkansas went up two in rank. Montana and Nebraska dropped in position the same number. In a ten-year period, it is interesting to observe what states have shown the most improvement in standing.

Arkansas has gone up nine places, Florida five, Washington and New Mexico four each, Indiana and Georgia three each. The all-time list follows with the 1959 rank included for comparison purposes.

In the fourteen events considered, 30 performances were better or equal to the winning marks of five years ago. Once again, the pole vault leads, followed by the high jump and mile relay.

Each year we publish the National Honor Roll, compiled by Bill Russell of the California Interscholastic Federation, for inclusion in the National Federation High School Track and Field Guide. Our thanks to both Bill Russell

and Cliff Fagan, executive secretary of the National Federation, for making this material available to us. In order to be accorded recognition on next year's Honor Roll, all noteworthy performances this spring should be sent to William W. Russell, 525 E. Hyde Park Place, Inglewood, Calif. 90302.

This year's Honor Roll carries 189 listings. As in other years, California with 63 performances leads, followed by Texas with 24 listings. Together these two states accounted for 46 per cent of all listings. Three years ago these two states had 58.1 per cent of the listings. The schools located in the Middle Atlantic, East North Central, West South Central, and Pacific regions had 72 per cent of the total listings. This is quite a drop from a high of 87.5 per cent in 1967. The previous low was 80 per cent in 1959.

The state meets, regionals, sections, and districts leading up to the finals provided 132 listings. The balance, 57 performances, were recorded in relays, invitational, and similar meets.

The Pacific section again was first but only .7 of a point ahead of the West South Central region of Arkansas, Louisiana, Oklahoma, and Texas, followed by the East North Central and Middle Atlantic sections, the same order as last year. The South Atlantic region of Delaware, Maryland, D.C., Virginia, North Carolina, South Carolina, Georgia, and Florida jumped from eighth place to fifth. The seventeen states included in the first four sections accounted for 68.3 per cent of the total points, a new low. The previous low total for these sections was 71.7 per cent in 1965, with the average for previous years running close to 80 per cent. The same states tallied 84.3 per cent in 1968, the high mark.

This year 162 new state records were broken compared with 215 new marks last year. Vermont with 9 new records was the leader, followed by Rhode Island, Florida, and Virginia. The pole vault continues to lead the other events with 18 new records, but tied by the one mile run. The two mile run and the mile relay each had 17 new marks.

This year's winning performances, the winning performances five years ago, and the number of performances this year which were better than or equal to the winners of five years ago are
