

NorCal Preps in Weekend Relays

Northern California prep trackmen, off to a faster start than last year's performers, head into their first major relay competition this weekend.

Relay meets, which bring together high schoolers from different areas, invariably result in better times and distances because competition is so much keener than in dual meets. Presently, this year's trackmen are ahead of last season's marks in 10 of the 15 listed events.

Scheduled for this weekend are the Santa Rosa Relays, the Martinez Relays, the Mt. Eden Relays at Chabot College, the Downey Invitational

at Modesto, the Vanden Relays at Travis AFB, the Morgan Hill Relays at Live Oak and the Blossom Hill Relays at Leigh High, San Jose.

Additionally, Fresno will hold its city meet today and tomorrow at McLane Stadium. Fresno trackmen rank among the top three in 10 events in The Chronicle's prep track bests.

If the weather is fair at these various locales, the "best" list should undergo major revision.

Four new leaders emerged in this week's listings, while three others improved on their previous bests.

Mike Murphy of Hoover (Fresno) took over the 440

leadership with 48.1, Robert Yslas of Madera jumped to the two-mile lead with 9:13.8, Louie Amps of Edison (Fresno) took over the 180-low hurdles with 18.9 and junior Al Dalerio of Clovis captured the top spot in the shot put with 62-3.

Previous leaders improving their marks were Clyde Lansing of Fresno, with a wind-aided 9.5 in the 100; Merced's 440-relay quartet with a 41.7 and junior long-jumper Heulon Hewitt of Merced with a leap of 23-11½. Hewitt also reached the elite among high jumpers with a 6-7 mark.

Although Lansing's mark is wind-aided, it was reported the wind had stopped at

the time of his run. However, since it was a blustery day and no wind gauge was used, the time carries the notation.

Last week, Edison of Fresno clipped off a 1:27.9 in the 880 relay at the North Yosemite League Relays. The relay is no longer a State Meet event, but Edison's time is the second best ever run in the San Joaquin Valley. The best half-mile relay time was 1:26.3, by Lemoore in 1963. A chap named Tommie Smith anchored Lemoore that year.

PREP PATTERN

The Northern California Basketball Officials Association recently honored Ev Shelton and Jim Witt at its annual dinner. Shelton retired this season as coach of Sacramento State College and Witt retired as an official. Elected as officers for the 1968-69 season were Erv Delman president; Owen Kashevaroff, vice president; Howard Powelson, secretary; Irv Winetrub, treasurer, Ron Gaggero, Dick Murray and Ron Ealy were named to the executive board.

Mel Gray, winner of the 100 and 220 in the State Track Meet last year while running for Montgomery (Santa Rosa), has accepted an invitation to run against Charlie Greene and Jim Hines in Saturday's 100-meter feature of the Kansas Relays. Gray, who last week tied the national junior college 100-yard dash mark of 9.3, is presently competing for Fort Scott Junior College in Kansas.

Herb Washington, a 17-year-old from Flint (Mich.) Central High, recently cracked the two remaining Mansfield (Ohio) Relays records of Jesse Owens. Washington won the 100 in 9.4, bettering Owens' mark of 9.6, and won the 220 in 21.0, two-tenths faster than Jesse when he prepped at Cleveland East Tech in the 1930s. In another exceptional performance, Mike McMannon of Newport (Ohio) Catholic long jumped 25-9.2.

Jerry Proctor, formerly of Pasadena Muir, who was the State Meet's first triple winner in 20 years in 1967, is presently leading the Nation's long jumpers with an outdoor leap of 26-4. In addition, the Redlands freshman has triple jumped 49-2½, run the 120 highs in 14.3 and the 100 in a wind-aided 9.4. In Redlands' first outdoor meet this season, Proctor won the 100, 220, high and intermediate hurdles, long jump, triple jump and ran a leg on the 400 relay team.

Preps Invade Fresno

Many of the outstanding prep athletes in Northern California will be spotlighted tomorrow during the West Coast Relays at Fresno.

The high schoolers, who will compete at Ratcliffe Stadium with junior college, college and university athletes, will perform from 3:30 p.m. to 9:30 p.m. Eighty-three schools have entered nearly 700 participants.

Although the prep field is numerically smaller than in past years, a more competitive meet is assured because standards were imposed on entrants this year.

For example, there will be 20 sprinters under 10.0 en-

tered in the 100 and 27 runners under 15.0 in the 120 high hurdles. These two events, plus the high jump and relays should bring about outstanding marks.

In the 100, 9.5 sprinters Warren Edmondson of Oakland, Clyde Lansing of Fresno and Ken Jones of South Bakersfield are expected to wage a tight battle.

The 120 highs will feature junior Jerry Wilson of Fresno Roosevelt (14.1), Clusie Smith of Lemoore (14.2) and Kirk Davis of Berkeley (14.3), among others.

The high jump will be closely watched mainly because of Otis Hailey, the Wasco senior who went 7-1/4

recently to set a national prep record.

The 440-relay will pit quartets from Merced (41.7), Fresno Edison (41.8), South Bakersfield (42.0), and Bakersfield (42.3) plus a flock of other sub-43 teams. The mile-relay, led by Berkeley's 3:20.1, should also prove exceptional.

PREP PATTER

As June graduation nears, high school athletes are making known where they'll be toiling next fall. Mike Stewart, Poly's 6-8 center, will attend Santa Clara along with 6-2 guard Tom Lunceford of Newark. Lloyd Allen, Selma's standout football and baseball performer, has signed a letter-of-intent to USC. Lincoln Minor, Ravenswood's 6-4, 217-pound football, basketball and track star, will enroll at New Mexico State as will St. Francis's Joe Klatt. George Ives of Lowell, who's on the North Shrine team, has signed to go to the University of Colorado.

Dick Rowe of Sacramento urges that the 330-yard intermediate hurdles replace the 180-yard high hurdles in California high school track meets. Dick says the 330H currently is run only in Kansas and Texas, but many California prep coaches would favor it over the 180 lows. Comment?

Ron Blackwood of Sanger has some additional information on high jumper Otis Hailey of Wasco. Hailey, who has the pending national prep record of 7-1/4, leaped 6-0 as a freshman, 6-5 as a soph, 6-8 as a junior and now as a senior, has a national record. Blackwood says Hailey's worst performance this season was 6-5 3/4 which placed him third at the Bellflower Relays. Andy Darby, who coached Hailey for three years, is now an assistant at Carlimont.

Prep fans will want to mark June 29 on their calendars. That's the date of the East-West all-star basketball game sponsored by the Exchange Club of Sunnyvale. It'll be held at 8 p.m. in the San Jose Civic Auditorium. Among those slated to play are Nate Williams of McClaymonds, Phil Chenier of Berkeley and Ainsley Truitt of Wilson. More information on this later.

San Francisco's AAA pulled off some surprises at the recent Castro Valley Invitational, in cold, blustery weather (like San Francisco's), Balboa's Andy Watkins beat 9.5 sprinter Warren Edmondson of Oakland in the 100 and won the outstanding track performer's trophy. Watkins trailed Edmondson by a foot and a half for the first 90-yards and then beat him by two feet. The winning time was 10 flat. Watkins also took the 220 around a turn in 21.7. Gary Wolf of Lowell sailed the discus 166-8 to take home the outstanding field performer's trophy.

Al Dalerio, a junior at Clovis who leads Northern California's shotputters, has been suspended for the rest of the season for disciplinary reasons by coach Bill Embrey. Dalerio had a best of 62-3.
