Carlmont High runs away with district track crown

REDWOOD CITY— Carlmont High School, Frazier Leslie and Jim Penrose were the trophy winners in the 13th annual Sequoia District Track and Field Championships at Terremere Field Friday night.

—The Scots won their 10th straight title by scoring 81 points compared to runnerup Sequoia who finished second with 64.

—Penrose set two meet records to capture the outstanding

field performer award. The big senior, headed for the Air Force Academy, threw the discus 174-11½ Tuesday but field event marks carry over and he broke the old mark of 174-6. In the shot put, Penrose threw a best-of-life 59-10¾ to set another mark and threaten to make a shambles of the league finals next week.

—Woodside's Leslie got sweet revenge when he easily defeated Carlmont's Jim Miller in both the high and low hurdles.

Earlier in the season Miller had beaten the talented senior twice.

The first event on the running calendar was the varisty 440 relay, Sequoia got precision passes and good starts to upset Menlo-Atherton in a fine time of 43.8. The Tribe also ended the meet is style, winning the mile relay with little trouble.

The best race of the night was the open 440 which had one of the closest finishes in recent history. San Carlos' Pete Phil-

lippe surprised everybody as he hit the tape ahead of Sequoia's Darryl White and Woodside's Chan Warden. The trio were all stopped in 50.6.

Ravenswood's Ron Sledge and Menlo-Atherton's sprint ace Bill Hatcher were the only double winner other than the meet's outstanding athletes.

Sledge won the long jump and high jump while Hatcher was victorious in the 220 and the 100.

The final meet record of the

evening was set by Carlmont's junior sensation Chris Carey. Carey went out fast in the first 440 to overwhelm the field and win going away in a record time of 4:23.0.

The Sequoia District Schools and the Palo Alto high schools will join forces Tuesday in the annual league championships trials at Foothill College.

The top men in each event will qualify for Friday's finals on the same track at 8 p.m.
