Gunn Wins Martinez Trackfest

MARTINEZ — Tiny Gunn High of Palo Alto proved that quality of performers, not quantity, makes the difference by dominating the small school division of the Martinez Track Relays here Saturday.

Competing against schools with enrollments up to 500 greater than its own 1,200, Gunn won four relays and placed in seven others to total 39 points, 14 better than runner-up San Ramon.

The unbeaten SPAL leaders won the 480 shuttle high hurdles in 1:04.1, with a 14.6 anchor leg from Keith Peters; the 440 relay in 45.2; the 880 relay in 1:33.9, and the mile relay in 3:30.9.

Turning in outstanding performances for Gunn were Tom Anderson, individual winner in the high jump (6-2) and long jump (21-8) in helping Gunn to seconds in both those relays (the marks of four men totaled), and Tom Birthwhistle, who threw the discus 179-0 to help Gunn to a second in that relay event.

In a dual-meet Saturday, host Menlo School won its fourth straight contest by downing Robert Louis Stevenson 83-39.
