

# Brown, Adams spark Los Altos to track victory

Los Altos High came up with double winners to easily win all competition in the ninth annual Hill-Kiwanis track meet at Foot College Saturday.

Rich Brown and Chris Adams pulled off double victories to lead the Knights to a big win and establish the Los Altos team crown.

A total of five records were broken and a sixth was tied.

58 teams competed for honor. Los Altos totaled 95 points

to run away from second place Homestead with 47 and third place Menlo-Atherton with 36.

Brown won his third 880 in the meet and was voted the outstanding track performer for the second year. The slender senior had a hand in three records.

Brown started by tying former San Jose State and Olympic champion Lee Evans's record in the 440 with a lifetime best of 48.1. Then he came back to run the 880 in another all-time low of 1:56.1.

Brown finished off his day's activities by anchoring the mile relay team in a 49.0 leg. The Knight squad set another meet record by posting a 3:19.8 clocking, a great early season mark.

Adams made it a clean sweep by taking the award for being the outstanding field performer for the second straight year.

Adams won the shot put with an outstanding 60-8 toss and captured his specialty — the discus — with a 189-8 effort. And just to keep his hand in the action, Adams walked off

with fourth place in the 100-yard dash in 10.4.

Rich Andrew won the 220 in 22.0 and took second to Brown in the 440 in 48.7. Steve Davis finished a strong second to Brown in the 880 with a 1:56.5 time. He also had a 49.2 leg on the mile relay team.

M-A's Ernie Reese joined Brown and Adams as repeat winners from last year. The Bear senior won the 100 in the comparatively slow time of 10.1. He beat Leonard Johnson of Overfelt who had clocked 10.0

in the trials. Reese was also third in the 220.

St. Francis's Bob McCarty turned in a fine early-season two mile effort of 9:12.2.
