Mack Runs 1:49.9 in Arcadia 800

David Mack of Locke ran the nation's fastest high school 800 meters of the year and anchored the Saints' 1,600-meter relay team to another national leading performance Saturday night at the Arcadia Invitational at Arcadia High.

In a heart-stopping 800 meters Jeff West of Crenshaw passed the 400 mark in a very relaxed 54.0 with Mack about three yards behind in second. West then applied the pressure in the third 200 and opened up a six-yard lead with 200 to go.

Mack slowly began to close the margin on West but it was only a last lunge at the tape that gave the Locke senior a 1:49.9 win. West was also timed in 1:49.9 for second.

The race was actually a preview of the City 800 final with Darryl Savage of Monroe third in 1:52.3 and James Jackson of Gardena fourth in 1:52.4.

Locke won the 1,600 relay in 3:13.1 with Mack anchoring in 47.1.

In the Girls division, Sherri Howard of San Gorgonio and Linda Goen of North Bakersfield were the stars.

Howard won the 400 in 53.8 but she saved the best for last as she anchored San Gorgonio's 1,000 relay. The winning time was 3:51.9 with a 52.9 split.

Goen returned to her form of two years ago with wins in the 800 (2:10.5) and the 1,500 (4:32.1).

Lee Bahn of Glendale won the high jump with a meet record of 7-0, breaking the old mark of 6-10 1/4 by Dennis Smith of Santa Monica.
