

# Mack Leads Locke to City Title

butors, who gave it a final total of 75, since runner-up Crenshaw could manage only 39.

Loud was the big winner in each of her events. She went 19-10 $\frac{1}{4}$  in the long jump, almost a foot ahead of teammate Debbie Hawes. Her 10.7 100 (hand-timed and wind-aided) and 24.40 220 (electronic) saw her running away from the field.

Gilbreth likewise dominated in the distance. Her mile time of 4:58.7 made her a winner by 100 yards and broke the 1977 record of 5:06.3 by Poly's Sheila Ralston. In the two-mile, Gilbreth was 40 yards ahead as she broke her own record of 11:07.1 with an 11:00.7.

In the boys competition, it was very tight with the evening's last three events to be completed. Locke led Banning only 40-38, with Fremont still in the running at 33.

But Banning's Leo Lopez failed to place in the pole vault. And when Locke won the mile relay in a City record 3:14.5, bettering its own record by a second, it locked up the title.

Mack won the 880 in a City record 1:50.7, the 440 in 48.29 and anchored the mile relay in 47.7. The toughest of those wins was the half-mile, where he passed Crenshaw's Jeffrey West on the last turn and won by a hair, with both given the same time.

Mack was supported by second places from Bobby Deary in the 330-yard low hurdles and Gary Kelly in the 440.

Banning got two firsts from Leon Reed in the 100 and 200, a win from Louie Faison in the triple jump and went two-three in the shot-put but had little else to offer. Fremont's best efforts were a winning 440-yard relay (41.9) and a second in the 100 by Parris Nixon.
