Records plentiful in Top 8 meet

Competition is the prime ingredient for top performances.

There were many season-best performances Saturday night when girls and boys virtually rewrote the record book at the third annual Central Coast Section Top 8 meet at Los Gatos High School.

Independence won the varsity boys crown, and Mitty and San Mateo shared the girls title. Overfelt and Saratoga tied for the frosh-soph crown.

But the emphasis was on competition, and there were some top individual performances — particularly in the girls meet, where Brenda Brewer of Hillsdale and sophomore Wendy Brown of Woodside were named outstanding track and field athletes, respectively.

Brewer, who won the same honor last year, ran the 200 meters in 24.6 and won the 400 in 55.6, both of which broke meet marks she set last year.

Brewer also anchored her Hillsdale 400-meter relay to a 48.6, which equaled the meet mark set by the Brewer-led Knight team of a year ago.

Brown, an amazing sophomore, was the outstanding individual in the meet with her field triple and a good effort in the 100-meter hurdles. Her best mark was a 19-2½ leap in the long jump that was not only a meet mark but also the best jump in the state this season.

Brown also won the triple jump with a 38-2 and the high jump at 5-4.

The Woodside representative was also in the race for gold in the 100-meter hurdles. She was battling eventual winner Roberta Eccles of Gunderson for the lead, but she hit the next to last hurdle and fell to the track while Eccles went on to win in a meet record 14.4.



High Schools

Larry Weldon of Silver Creek leaped 48-1¾ to win the triple jump and claim boys field honors and Brian Bergstrom of Los Gatos, running on his home track, ran a 63-second last lap to win the mile in 4:21.1. The latter's time was good enough in the minds of the judges who voted him boys track honors.

Rivaling Bergstrom for individual honors were Rod Green of Palo Alto, who skipped over the 110-meter highs in a meet record 13.9 and Kerry Threats of Westmoor, who broke his own meet mark of 48.8 with a 48.3 in the 400-meter race. He also anchored the Rams mile relay team to victory in 3:22.2.

Green did not get one of his better starts, but he was in the lead by the time he had reached the first hurdle.

"I don't know that it was a bad start," Green commented, "but it is the part of my race that I must work on more. I felt good the rest of the race."

Threats did not talk much about his 400 because he's looking ahead.

"I am anxious to see what I can do next week at that meet in San Jose," said the speedster from Westmoor in Daly City. "All the good quartermilers from the north should be there, and I want to see how I stack up with the people outside our section."

The meet to which Threats referred was the Quicksilver Classic scheduled Saturday afternoon at San Jose City College.

Girls accounted for eight meet marks and the boys five. The boys also tied another when Mike Kibort of Saratoga soared 15-0 to win the pole vault.

In addition to those already mentioned, Andy

Sythe of Los Gatos leaped 22-9¾ to claim the long jump record, and the Mt. Pleasant 400-meter relay team with Kenny Williams coming from behind on the anchor to nip Independence, clocked 42.0.

Meet records in addition to those by Brewer and Woods included Eccles' 14.4 in the 100-meter hurdles; Cindy Durchslag of San Carlos, who cracked her own discus and shot put marks with 149-2 and 42-10½ efforts, and the Saratoga mile relay team that handed Mitty its first loss of the year with a 4:00.3 mark.

Frosh-Soph athletes also sparkled with four meet records and a share of three others.

One of the truly fine marks was posted by Overfelt's Sean Crowley, whose 4:24.3 broke the meet mile mark of 4:31.0 by Bergstrom two years ago.
