Multi-Event: Sub Bantam, Bantam, Sub Midget, Midget, Sub Youth, Youth, Intermediate, and Young Women/Young Men  
Relays: Bantam, Midget, Youth, Intermediate, and Young Women/Young Men

**AGE DETERMINATION:** The athlete's year of birth shall determine the age division in which he/she will compete:

Intermediate	1990 – 1991
*Young Men/Young Women	1988 – 1989

\*Athletes who are still eighteen (18) years of age through the final day of the National Track & Field Meet shall be eligible to compete in Young Men and Young Women divisions.

**ENTRY DEADLINE:** Entries must be **RECEIVED** no later than **Friday, July 14, 2006**. All Track & Field and Multi-Events forms are to be sent to the appropriate address below. It is important that all forms be completed and returned with the entry fee. **ALL ENTRIES MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE DEADLINE DATE OR YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO COMPETE. NO EXCEPTIONS! POSTMARK OR DATE OF SHIPMENT IS NOT RELEVANT. BOTH COPIES OF THE ENTRY FORM MUST BE RETURNED TO THE 2006 AAU JUNIOR OLYMPIC GAMES OFFICE. DO NOT FOR ANY REASON KEEP EITHER COPY!**

**ENTRY CONFIRMATION:** **IF YOU HAVE SENT YOUR PACKET VIA AN OVERNIGHT SERVICE (i.e. FedEx, UPS, Priority Mail) YOU CAN TRACK THE PACKET WITH THE AIRBILL NUMBER. IF YOUR PACKET HAS BEEN SIGNED FOR, THEN YOUR ENTRY WILL BE PROCESSED.**

The Local Organizing Committee has spent many hours planning and preparing for this event. In order to make it a great success, we are asking for your cooperation. It is the responsibility of the coach, designated person of the club, or athlete to return **all** the necessary monies and completed forms by the **deadline date**. It is not the responsibility of the LOC or the AAU to make sure all are completed, **ONLY TO ACCEPT OR REJECT ENTRY (S) BASED ON DOCUMENTS SUBMITTED.**

**ENTRY FEE:** \$35.00 per athlete for Multi-Events  
\$35.00 per athlete for Track & Field regardless of the number of events

**ALL FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE. Entry fees are per athlete, no substitutions allowed after submission. NO PERSONAL CHECKS WILL BE ACCEPTED.** All entry fees must be in the form of either a **cashier's check or money order** made payable to the **2006 AAU Junior Olympic Games**. Please do not send cash. If competing in both multi-events and track & field, two separate entry fees of \$35.00 each must be submitted along with the appropriate entry forms. Please note that all athletes will receive one credential and one goodie bag regardless of the number of sports or events in which they register.

**AAU MEMBERSHIP:** All athletes and coaches must be current members of their AAU District **prior** to their District meet, and **be able to present their AAU membership cards at the time of check-in**. All relay teams must present current 2006 AAU Club membership at check-in. Athlete membership is \$12 and coach (non-athlete) membership is \$14.

**QUALIFICATION:** **TRACK & FIELD:** The top four (4) finishers in each individual event or relay at each 2006 AAU Regional Track and Field Championship will qualify to compete.  
**MULTI-EVENTS:** The top four (4) finishers from each AAU Regional Championships will qualify to compete.  
**CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS:** The AAU National Club Championships will be held at Disney's Wide World of Sports® in Orlando, FL. The top four (4) finishers (regardless of Regional placement) will qualify for the AAU Junior Olympic Games in that event only. Athletes must declare their entry by submitting the proper paperwork and the \$35.00 entry fee to the address on the entry form, and must be received no later than **Friday, July 14, 2006**.  
These are the only methods of qualification for competition in this event. \* **NO WAIVERS WILL BE GRANTED.**

**PROTESTS:** Protests concerning the status or eligibility of any competitor must be made to the Games Committee prior to the commencement of the meet, or to the Referee during the meet. Protests relating to matters which develop during the conduct of the meet must be made to the Referee and be filed at once, but in any case not more than 30 minutes after the result has been announced. Written protests at the National level, protests MUST be filed on official protest forms and accompanied by a cash deposit of \$150.00. The National Meet Director will cause the results of each event to be marked with the correct time and date. The Referee shall consider any and all available evidence, except photographic evidence other than official films or official videotapes. When the Referee renders his decision, there is still the right of appeal to the Jury of Appeals, whose decision is final. If the protest is denied, the cash deposit will be forfeited.

**COMPETITOR CHECK-IN:** **TRACK:** Track athletes for running events will report to Clerk's tent, one hour before start of event.  
**FIELD:** Field event athletes will report to the chief official of that event, no less than one hour before the start of their event.

Athletes, who fail to report on time will not be allowed to compete in that event, after check-in has been closed. It is the athletes, coaches, and parents who are responsible to report on time, not meet management.

**RELAYS:** **YOU MUST SUBMIT INDIVIDUAL ENTRY FORM AND ENTRY FEE FOR EACH ATHLETE (INCLUDING ALTERNATES) LISTED ON RELAY FORM; OTHERWISE THE ENTIRE RELAY TEAM WILL BE SCRATCHED.**

**RELAY ENTRY FORMS MAY NOT HAVE ADDITIONS OR REPLACEMENTS AFTER BEING SUBMITTED TO THE NATIONAL MEET.**

**RELAYS: AN ATHLETE CANNOT BE ENTERED AS A MEMBER, OR AS AN ALTERNATE MEMBER, ON MORE THAN ONE RELAY TEAM FOR THE SAME RELAY EVENT.**

**AWARDS:** AAU Junior Olympic Games medals will be awarded to the top eight (8) finishers in each age division and a plaque will be awarded to the first place relay team in each age division. The first place individual finisher and first place relay team in each event and each age division will be honored as "All American" and receive the appropriate patch.

**MULTI-EVENTS SCORING TABLES:** The IAAF scoring tables will be used for all Age Divisions. Boys hurdle races shorter than 110 meters are scored from the Men's 110 meter hurdle tables. Girls hurdle races shorter than 100 meters are scored from the Women's 100 meter hurdle tables. Times for Sub Midget and Midget Boys 80 meter hurdles shall be multiplied by 1.13 prior to entering the tables; For the Sub Midget and Midget Girls 80 meter hurdles, multiply by 1.07. These calculations are included in the Hy-Tek program used for scoring purposes.

**MULTI-EVENTS RULES:** The rules of the NGB shall apply, with the following Multi-Events differences:  
a. In the long jump, shot put, discus throw, and the javelin throw, each competitor shall be allowed three (3) trials only.  
b. No penalty shall be imposed for the first false start, but the Starter shall disqualify the offender or offenders on the second false start. False starts are called on individuals, not on the field.

PACKET PICK-UP:**

**Pre-Registration:** It is extremely important that all entries be **RECEIVED** at the 2006 AAU JUNIOR OLYMPIC GAMES office no later than the previously mentioned deadline date. **ENTRY FORM(S) RECEIVED BEYOND THAT DATE WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED!** Of course, we want as many athletes as possible to participate, so please get all entry forms in on time. **AGAIN, GUARANTEED OVERNIGHT DELIVERY WILL BECOME MANDATORY IF IT IS THE ONLY WAY TO ENSURE COMPLIANCE WITH THE DEADLINE DATE!**

**On-Site Check-In:** Check-in days will vary depending on events entered. Please refer to the event schedule. Check-in for all participants in the AAU Junior Olympic Games will be held at the **Virginia Beach Convention Center** located at 1000 19<sup>th</sup> Street, Virginia Beach, VA 23451. On-site parking is complimentary. **NOTE TO ALL TRACK ATHLETES, COACHES AND PARENTS:** ATHLETES/COACHES/PARENTS MUST GO TO THE VIRGINIA BEACH CONVENTION CENTER IN ORDER TO CHECK-IN AND PICK UP THE ATHLETE BIB NUMBERS.

**Directions to the Virginia Beach Convention Center**

- Take I-264 East to the end of the interstate.
- Take a right on Parks Avenue (first stop light at the end of the expressway)
- Continue on Parks for about a block (crossing over 19<sup>th</sup> Street).
- Complimentary parking for the Convention Center is located on the right.

**BIB NUMBER PICK-UP: THE REPLACEMENT COST FOR ANY LOST BIB NUMBER (REGARDLESS OF THE CIRCUMSTANCES) WILL BE \$10.00.** All race numbers (multi-events included) must be picked up at the central athlete check-in location, which will be located at the Virginia Beach Convention Center. Race (bib) number pick-up is a MANDATORY part of the athlete check-in process. Multi-event athletes competing in the track and field competition will use the same race number for both competitions. It is the responsibility of the head coach and parents to ensure that all of his/her athletes receive their race (bib) numbers as part of the check-in process. Coaches may pick up the numbers for their athletes.

**CLUB COACHES:**

For Track & Field coaches only. At this year's event, coaches submitting entry forms as a club/team will receive coaches' credentials based on the following formula (**Only if all returned entries are included in the same packet/envelope**):

1-8 Athletes	<b>NO</b> Complimentary Coaches Credentials for club ( <b>\$35.00 fee must be paid</b> )
9-16 Athletes	One (1) complimentary Coaches Credential per club
17-25 Athletes	Two (2) complimentary Coaches Credentials per club
Over 25 Athletes*	Three (3) complimentary Coaches Credentials per club

**\*A Maximum of three (3) complimentary Coaches Credentials will be given to any given club. All other coaches wishing to participate in the event must submit separate entry forms and pay the \$35.00 coaches entry fee. There will be a \$10.00 late entry fee assessed for coaches registrations received after the entry deadline or if registering at on-site check-in.**

**NOTE: THE ONLY WAY TO RECEIVE COMPLIMENTARY COACHES CREDENTIALS IS IF THE CLUB/TEAM ROSTER FORM IS SUBMITTED ALONG WITH THE FOLLOWING APPROPRIATE FORMS:**

1. TRACK AND FIELD INDIVIDUAL ATHLETE ENTRY FORM FOR EACH ATHLETE LISTED ON THE ROSTER FORM
2. TRACK AND FIELD BOYS'/GIRLS' RELAY TEAM ENTRY FORM (If applicable) AND
3. TRACK AND FIELD COACH'S ENTRY FORM - FOR EACH COACH

**REMINDER: COMPLIMENTARY CREDENTIALS WILL ONLY BE MADE AVAILABLE (ACCORDING TO THE ABOVE PRESCRIBED FORMULA) TO THOSE COACHES WHO SUBMIT THE CLUB/TEAM ROSTER ALONG WITH ALL APPLICABLE ENTRY FORMS (LISTED ABOVE) TOGETHER AT THE SAME TIME - IN ONE (1) RETURN ENTRY PACKET/ENVELOPE!**

**ALL COACHES MUST BE CURRENT AAU MEMBERS AND PRESENT THEIR MEMBERSHIP CARD AT CHECK-IN.**

- COOLERS:** Only credentialed athletes and coaches will be allowed to bring coolers into Dick Price Stadium. Anyone with medical needs will be allowed as well. Coolers are subject to search as are all other bags, jackets, etc.
- TENTS:** **Tents or shading devices may only be set up in the top five rows of the upper bleachers.** Tents in the bleacher sections next to the press box are prohibited. No tents may extend further than the top five rows. There will be areas outside of the stadium available for setting up tents. Tents left overnight are not the responsibility of the AAU.
- CELEBRATION OF ATHLETES:** The 2006 AAU Junior Olympic Games ***Celebration of Athletes*** will be held at Dick Price Stadium on the campus of Norfolk State University on Monday, July 31 at 7:30 p.m. All athletes are encouraged to attend, as you won't want to miss this year's celebration. **The finals for the 200 M Hurdles (SYG, SYB, YG, YB) will take place during the Celebration. Come out and support your fellow track athletes!** Parking is limited on the campus of Norfolk State University. To facilitate your arrival at the event, there will be a shuttle system available. The shuttle buses will run continuously from designated parking areas prior to the event and will be returning to the parking lots immediately following the ceremony. A detailed map will be provided at athlete check-in.
- HOUSING:** Anthony Travel is the official housing agency for the AAU Junior Olympic Games in Hampton Roads. Anthony Travel will handle all requests for hotels. 1. The sport in which you will compete
  2. The number of people in your party
  3. The number of rooms you need
  4. Your arrival and departure dates
  5. Your credit card number
- Important: Hotels may require a deposit. Please check with Anthony Travel regarding deposit requirements and cancellation policies. AAU is not responsible for any refunds from cancellations.
- PARKING:** The majority of venues for the 2006 AAU Junior Olympic Games will offer complimentary parking. However, some locations may have parking fees including Chrysler Hall, Norfolk State University and the Hampton Roads Convention Center.
- Also, please note that some hotels will charge for parking at their location. These prices vary. Please contact your hotel directly for more information on parking fees.
- TRANSPORTATION:** All athletes, coaches, and fans are responsible for their own transportation to and from all activities, events, and hotels.
- SECURITY:** All 2006 AAU Junior Olympic Games facilities maintain the right to search any bags, backpacks, purses, jackets, etc. throughout the duration of the 2006 AAU Junior Olympic Games.
- FOOD:** All 2006 AAU Junior Olympic Games facilities maintain exclusive rights to concessions. Outside food and beverage are not permitted throughout the duration of the 2006 AAU Junior Olympic Games.
- ADMISSION FEE:** Each sport is a part of the 2006 AAU Junior Olympic Games. Admission to all venues and the Celebration of Athletes for credentialed participants only is included in your entry fee. Please note that you must check-in and pick up your athlete or coach credential prior to receiving admittance into any venue, including the Celebration of Athletes. All other spectators will be able to enjoy any of the events throughout the 2006 AAU Junior Olympic Games by purchasing an admission ticket that is valid for all the sports involved in the Games.
