ONLINE ENTRY:	Entries will only be accepted ONLINE at <u>www.aaujrogames.org</u> . Visa, MasterCard, American Express and Discover accepted. NO EXCEPTIONS!! All entries are NON-REFUNDABLE and NON-TRANSFERABLE.				
ENTRY DEADLINE:	All ATHLETE Online Entries must be submitted no later than <u>Tuesday, July 17, 2007 at 11:59 p.m. EST.</u> ALL ENTRIES MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE DEADLINE DATE OR YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO COMPETE.				
	The Local Organizing Committee has spent many hours planning and preparing for this event. In order to make it a great success, we are asking for your cooperation. It is the responsibility of the coach, designated person of the club, or athlete to make sure all athletes are registered online at <u>www.aaujrogames.org</u> . It is not the responsibility of the LOC or the AAU to make sure all are completed, ONLY TO ACCEPT OR <u>REJECT</u> ENTRY (S) BASED ON ENTRIES SUBMITTED.				
ONLINE REGISTRATON:	Once on-line meet entry is accepted, no changes can be made. Upon completion of the on-line entry process, including the payment of the entry fee, athlete entries are locked and a confirmation e-mail is sent showing all athletes and events entered. Athletes can be added until on-line meet entry is closed, but the entry and roster record of locked athletes cannot be changed. The entry of a locked athlete cannot be removed, nor can the entry of a locked athlete be swapped for another. There will be <b>NO EXCEPTIONS</b> . The person who enters the athletes on-line assumes full responsibility for the events entered on-line. If an e-mail confirmation of an entry is not received within 24-hours, it is the responsibility of the person entering the athletes to contact the National Office.				

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NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE ENTERTAINED.

ENTRY FEE: \$40.00 per athlete for Multi-Events \$40.00 per athlete for Track & Field regardless of the number of events ALL FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE AND NON-TRANSFERABLE. Entry fees are per athlete, no substitutions allowed after submission. All athlete entries must be made online. Visa, MasterCard, American Express and Discover accepted. If competing in both multi-events and track & field, two separate entry fees of \$40.00 each must be paid. Please note that all athletes will receive one credential and one goodie bag regardless of the number of sports or events in which they register. All athletes and coaches must be current members of their AAU District prior to their District meet, and be able AAU MEMBERSHIP: to present their AAU membership cards at the time of check-in. All relay teams must present current 2007 AAU Club membership at check-in. Athlete membership is \$12, coach (non-athlete) membership is \$14 and club membership starts at \$30. Visit www.aausports.org for more information and to register for membership. TRACK & FIELD: The top four (4) finishers in each individual event or relay at each 2007 AAU Regional Track **QUALIFICATION:** and Field Championship will gualify to compete. MULTI-EVENTS: The top four (4) finishers from each AAU Regional Championships will qualify to compete. CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS: The AAU National Club Championships will be held from July 1<sup>st</sup> thru July 6<sup>th</sup> at Disney's Wide World of Sports® in Orlando, FL. (Visit www.aauathletics.org for information). Only the top four (4) finishers will qualify for the AAU Junior Olympic Games in that event only. Athletes must declare their entry by registering online at www.aaujrogames.org no later than Tuesday, July 17, 2007. These are the only methods of qualification for competition in this event. \* NO WAIVERS WILL BE GRANTED. PROTESTS: Protests concerning the status or eligibility of any competitor must be made to the Games Committee prior to the commencement of the meet, or to the Referee during the meet. Protests relating to matters which develop during the conduct of the meet must be made to the Referee and be filed at once, but in any case not more than 30 minutes after the result has been announced. Written protests at the National level, protests MUST be filed on official protest forms, must include the Rule #, the page # in the Rule Book, and accompanied by a cash deposit of \$150.00. The National Meet Director will cause the results of each event to be marked with the correct time and date. The Referee shall consider any and all available evidence, except photographic evidence other than official films or official videotapes. When the Referee renders his decision, there is still the right of appeal to the Jury of Appeals, whose decision is final. If the protest is denied, the cash deposit will be forfeited. COMPETITOR CHECK-IN: TRACK: Track athletes for running events will report to Clerk's tent, one hour before start of event. FIELD: Field event athletes will report to the chief official of that event, no less than one hour before the start of their event. Athletes, who fail to report on time will not be allowed to compete in that event, after check-in has been closed. (Check-in is closed when the first athlete begins competition in each event.) It is the athletes, coaches, and parents who are responsible to report on time, not meet management. YOU MUST REGISTER AND PAY THE ENTRY FEE FOR EACH ATHLETE (INCLUDING ALTERNATES) **RELAYS:** LISTED ON EACH RELAY TEAM; OTHERWISE THE ENTIRE RELAY TEAM WILL BE SCRATCHED. ONCE A RELAY TEAM HAS BEEN REGISTERED ONLINE, NO ADDITIONS OR REPLACEMENTS CAN BE MADE FOR THAT RELAY TEAM. NO CHANGES WILL BE ALLOWED AT CHECK-IN! RELAYS: AN ATHLETE CANNOT BE ENTERED AS A MEMBER, OR AS AN ALTERNATE MEMBER, ON MORE THAN ONE RELAY TEAM FOR THE SAME RELAY EVENT. **MULTI-EVENTS** SCORING TABLES: The IAAF scoring tables will be used for all Age Divisions. Boys hurdle races shorter than 110 meters are scored from the Men's 110 meter hurdle tables. Girls hurdle races shorter than 100 meters are scored from the Women's 100 meter hurdle tables. Times for Sub Midget and Midget Boys 80 meter hurdles shall be multiplied by 1.13 prior to entering the tables; For the Sub Midget and Midget Girls 80 meter hurdles, multiply by 1.07. These calculations are included in the Hy-Tek program used for scoring purposes. **MULTI-EVENTS RULES:** The rules of the NGB shall apply, with the following Multi-Events differences: In the long jump, shot put, discus throw, and the javelin throw, each competitor shall be allowed three (3) a. trials only.

b. No penalty shall be imposed for the first false start, but the Starter shall disqualify the offender or offenders on the second false start. False starts are called on individuals, not on the field.

AWARDS:

AAU Junior Olympic Games medals will be awarded to the top eight (8) finishers in each age division and a plaque will be awarded to the first place relay team in each age division. The first place individual finisher and first place relay team in each event and each age division will be honored as "All American" and receive the appropriate patch.

CHECK-IN/ PACKET PICK-UP:

Pre-Registration: It is extremely important that all entries be submitted ONLINE no later than the deadline date. ENTRIES RECEIVED BEYOND THAT DATE WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED BY THE ONLINE REGISTRATION SYSTEM.

On-Site Check-In: Check-In for all athletes, coaches, clubs and teams participating in the AAU Junior Olympic Games will be held at the Jacob Building at Chilhowee Park located at 3301 Magnolia Avenue, Knoxville, TN 37914. Please follow the posted signs to the Check-In Area. Athletes must check-in at the Jacob Building at Chilhowee Park at least the day prior to the first day of his/her competition. #### **Directions to the Jacob Building at Chilhowee Park**

#### From the McGhee Tyson Knoxville Airport:

Take US-129N towards Knoxville, Take I-40 East towards Asheville, Take Exit 392 (Rutledge Pike/Knoxville Zoo Drive), Follow signs to the Knoxville Zoo.

From the North (I-75): I-75 South toward Knoxville, Take I-275 South toward Asheville, Take Exit 3 toward Asheville, Merge onto I-640 East, Take I-40 West toward Nashville, Take Exit 392A (Rutledge Pike/Knoxville Zoo Drive) and merge onto Rutledge Pike/TN-1/US-11W, Follow signs to the Knoxville Zoo.

From the South (I-75): I-75 North to I-40 East, Follow I-40 East towards Knoxville, Take Exit 392 (Rutledge Pike/Knoxville Zoo Drive). Follow signs to the Knoxville Zoo.

From the East (I-40): I-40 West towards Knoxville, Take Exit 392A (Rutledge Pike / Knoxville Zoo Drive), Merge onto Rutledge Pike/TN-1/US-11W, Follow signs to Knoxville Zoo.

From the West (I-40): I-40 East toward Knoxville, Follow I-40 East toward Asheville, Take Exit 392 (Rutledge Pike/Knoxville Zoo Drive), Follow signs to the Knoxville Zoo.

- BIB NUMBER PICK-UP: THE REPLACEMENT COST FOR ANY LOST BIB NUMBER (REGARDLESS OF THE CIRCUMSTANCES) WILL BE \$10.00. All race numbers (multi-events included) must be picked up at the central athlete check-in location, which will be located at the Jacob Building in Chilhowee Park. Race (bib) number pick-up is a MANDATORY part of the athlete check-in process. Multi-event athletes competing in the track and field competition will use the same race number for both competitions. It is the responsibility of the head coach and parents to ensure that all of his/her athletes receive their race (bib) numbers as part of the check-in process. Coaches may pick up the numbers for their athletes.
- **CLUB COACHES:** For Track & Field coaches only. At this year's event, coaches for a club/team will receive coaches' credentials based on the following formula:

1-8 Athletes	NO Complimentary Coaches Credentials for club (\$40.00 coach entry fee must be paid)			
9-16 Athletes	One (1) complimentary Coaches Credential per club			
17-25 Athletes	Two (2) complimentary Coaches Credentials per club			
Over 25 Athletes*	Three (3) complimentary Coaches Credentials per club			

\*A Maximum of three (3) complimentary Coaches Credentials will be given to any given club. All coaches must register online to receive the complimentary pass. Additional coaches may also register online and pay the \$40.00 coaches' entry fee. There will be a \$10.00 late entry fee assessed for coaches' registrations received after July 20 or if registering at on-site check-in.

**INSTRUCTIONS ON RECEIVING COACHES PASSES:** 

- 1. The Club/Team Contact can visit <u>www.aaujrogames.org</u> and log into the track coaches' online registration program.
- 2. You will need to add the coaches' AAU membership number and zip code listed on their AAU membership card.
- 3. You will be given complimentary coaches entries based on the formula above and/or will be charged for any additional coaches. Please note, it does take approximately 24 hours after you register an athlete for him/her to count towards your club total.
- 4. NO REFUNDS will be given for coaches.

REMINDER: COMPLIMENTARY CREDENTIALS WILL ONLY BE MADE AVAILABLE (ACCORDING TO THE ABOVE PRESCRIBED FORMULA).

ALL COACHES (those who receive a complimentary pass or pay the \$40 entry fee) MUST BE CURRENT AAU MEMBERS AND PRESENT THEIR MEMBERSHIP CARD AT CHECK-IN.

COOLERS: Only credentialed athletes and coaches will be allowed to bring coolers into Tom Black Track. Anyone with medical needs will be allowed as well. Coolers are subject to search as are all other bags, jackets, etc.

TENTS: Tents or shading devices may NOT be brought in to the stadium. No exceptions. Tents will only be allowed in a designated area outside of the track. Tents left overnight are not the responsibility of the AAU.

CELEBRATION OF ATHLETES:

The 2007 AAU Junior Olympic Games **Celebration of Athletes** will be held at Chilhowee Park located at 3301 Magnolia Avenue on Monday, July 30 at 6:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. All athletes are encouraged to attend, as you won't want to miss this year's celebration.
