3. Pre-season meeting on Monday, January 5, 2004 at the Athletic Office @ 3:30 pm.
4. Eligibility lists and non-league schedules are due no later than five days before the first scheduled non-league contest. If there are no non-league contests then eligibility lists are due on March 17th.
5. Varsity boys/girls city championship entries are due on Monday, May 10, 2004. OK to make time changes and additions up to May 14. **NO EXEMPTIONS!!**
6. Any change in the entry sheet will be made at the discretion of the starter and clerk of the course only.
7. All championship entries are to be inputted via your team manager software. No hand written entries will be accepted!
8. Varsity Boys and Girls seeding meeting will be held on Friday May 14, 2004 - Athletic Office, Room 250 @ 3:45 pm.
9. Post season meeting will be on Tuesday June 1, 2004 Athletic Office @ 4:00 pm.

12. Maximum spike length at McAteer(SOTA), Washington, Burton and Kezar is 3/16 inch spikes. ***(1/4 inch and longer will not be allowed.)***
