2. CHAMPIONSHIP FORMAT

- a. Host Conference: Metro Ian Cumming, Otay Ranch, Director, assisted by James Coates, Mar Vista.
- b. All schools that submit a timely, official entry form are eligible to compete.
- c. There are no prelims in the CIFSDS Cross Country Championships.
- d. The 2004 San Diego CIF Cross Country Championships will be conducted in five divisions, and the October 2003 CBED enrollment figures shall determine division placement (breakdown is attached).
- e. Ten students may be entered as a Cross Country team for the Finals, but only seven may run, and only five shall be counted (except in the case of a tie breaker). Ties will be resolved by counting the sixth finisher from each team concerned. Seventh runner will displace.
- f. Entry forms have been mailed to Boys' and Girls' Cross Country Coaches. They are also available on the CIFSDS web site at <u>www.cifsds.org</u> - click on Sports, click on Fall, click on Cross Country. <u>Entry</u> <u>deadline</u> for submittal to CIFSDS Office is <u>October 29</u>. <u>There will be a \$75 fee for late entries</u> <u>postmarked after the deadline</u>. If SDCOE "truck mail" is used to deliver entries, those received in the CIFSDS Office after the established deadline will be subject to the \$75 late fee. NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER 12 NOON WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 17, 2004.
- g. Protests will be handled by the Meet Directors.
