Graham was the only CCS athlete qualifying for two finals while Susan Springer (Salinas), like Graham, made the grade in the weight events for the girls.

One of the most impressive events is the high jump, where 11 advanced to the finals with 6-9 jumps.

No entry from the CCS made it in the high jump. Only one, Bill Graber (Los Altos), had ever scaled the height—with his best of 6-9½—but he did only 6-2 Friday with Doug Wright (Live Oak) and Joel Wyrick (Mt. Pleasant) failing to qualify with their 6-6 efforts.

Among the impressive individuals going into today's finals are Ron Williams of Chatsworth, who will run the 100, 220 and 440, and Linda Goen of North H.S., Bakersfield, who will attempt the tough 880-mile double, where she faces a top field led by Regan and Bray.

35 Survive From CCS

LOS ANGELES—The Central Coast Section will have 18 boys and 17 girls striving for glory in the California Interscholastic Federation Track & Field Championships today on the lightning-fast UCLA track.

A total of 15 boys and 14 girls advanced to the finals with stellar efforts in Friday's trials, which saw meet marks fall in the girls' 440 and mile relays and discus throw with another being equalled when James Sanford ripped off a hand-timed 20.7 in the 220 yard dash.

Trials were held in every event except the two-mile.

Crawford High of San Diego ran 46.9 for a meet mark in the girls' 440 relay, just off their pending national mark of 46.6. Locke of Los Angeles did 3:54.2 in the mile relay, and Bonnie Dasse of Costa Mesa threw the discus 134-8. The latter's mark, although a meet record, will not count toward today's finals when competition starts anew among the nine qualifiers.

The CCS qualified all three entries in the boys' mile and discus events and the girls have all three of their entries in the 880 and low hurdles.

John Sup (Palma) and Stan Ross (Serra) won the mile heats with Mark Stillman (Willow Glen) running easily in third place in the first heat behind Sup's 4:13.9. Stillman did 4:15.3. Ross won the tough second heat in 4:10.2.

Tom Peterson (North Salinas), Pat Graham (Leland) and John Phillip Souza (Piedmont Hills) advanced in the discus, Graham making the grade after he paced the shot put qualifying with a lifetime best of 62-6.

Andre Phillips won his heat of the 330 lows in 36.7, but he'll face stubborn opposition led by Ramon Grubbs (Muir of Pasadena) and Chuck Gangnuss (Dublin), who were impressive winners in the other heats. One was so swift that Mark Chapman (Yerba Buena) failed to qualify despite running 37.1.

Heat winners among the CCS girls were Marquita Belk (Silver Creek) in the 440; Ann Regan (Camden), 880; Vicky Bray (Los Altos), mile; and Kris Costello (Lynbrook), 110 low hurdles. The latter tied with Lisa Gourdine (El Toro) for the best time of the day at 14.1.

Regan won her heat in 2:14.2, slower than Nancy Huyck's (Aptos) 2:13.7 that took third in the third heat.

Miss Belk, 440 record holder at 55.2, won her heat in 56.43. The fastest race was turned in by Arlise Emerson (Westminster) with a 55.9. Valerie Brisco (Locke of Los Angeles) won the other race in 56.2 and she is expected to provide Belk with the stiffest opposition in today's finals.

Sanford was the day's standout as he also qualified in the 220 and both relays, where he led the Bulldogs to the fastest clockings.

Sanford closed out the trials with a spectacular 45.5 leg in the mile relay, coming from five yards back to overtake and beat Fremont by a good eight yards in 3:14.0.

Sanford is the key to Pasadena hopes for a team crown, with Fremont of Los Angeles given a good chance.

Crawford (San Diego), Centennial (Compton) and Locke are the top picks in the girls' competition.

Among the CCS casualties was Paul Bates (Menlo-Atherton) in the triple jump, but he did make it in the long jump despite a painful foot injury that he's been nursing for a month.

The CCS failed to qualify a relay team in the boys' division and
