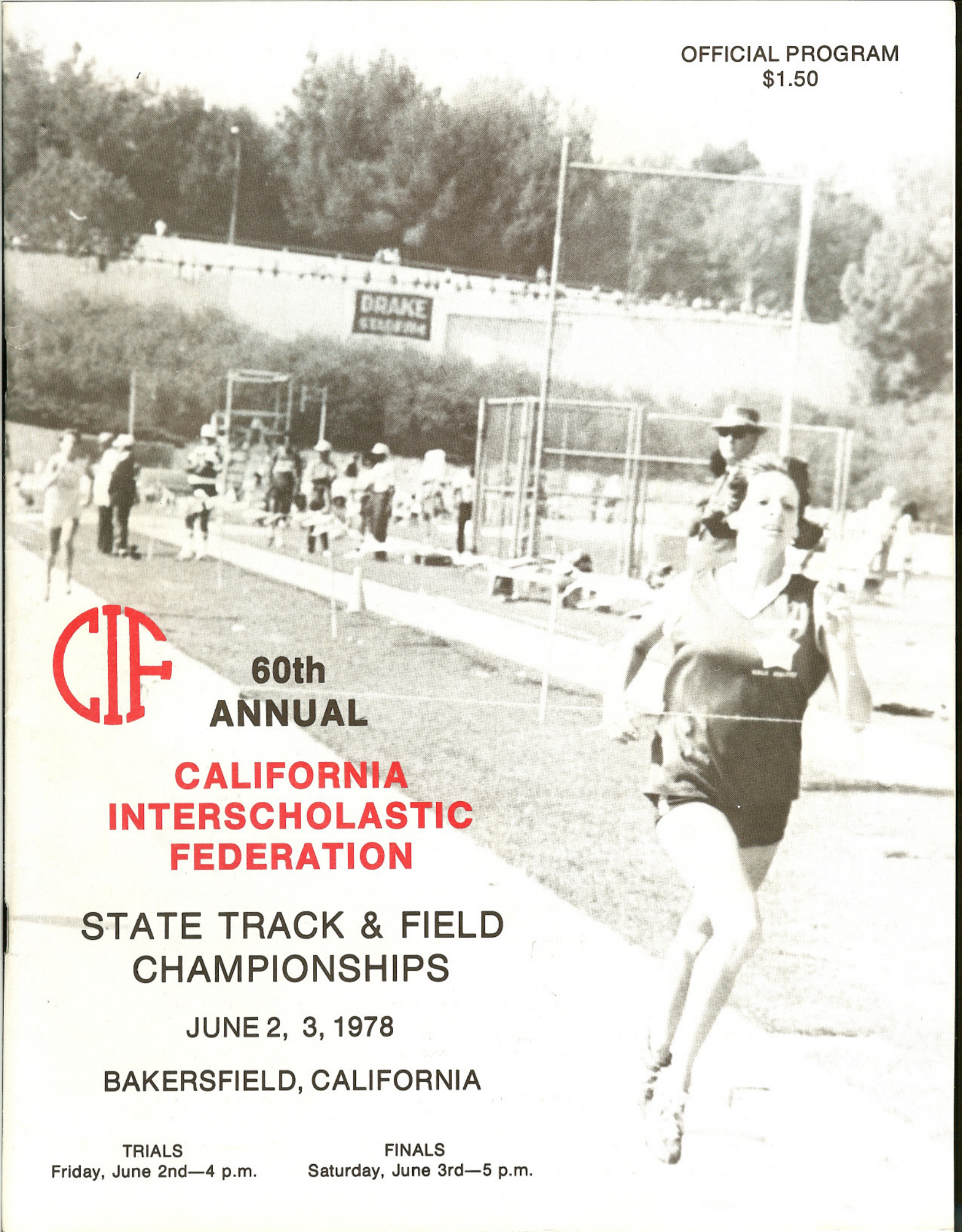

"THE CIF STORY"

California's State High School Track and Field Championship Meet is recognized as THE most outstanding interscholastic track event in the United States. The meet also signifies the leadership of the California Interscholastic Federation in fostering sportsmanlike competition among public and private schools throughout the state.

Formed in 1914, the State Federation's general purpose has been to serve as the agency through which member high schools may cooperatively adopt rules and regulations under which the schools could conduct their interscholastic athletic programs.

The 1978 State CIF Championship Track and Field Meet will be the sixtieth state championship. The first State CIF Track Meet for boys was conducted in 1915, and the first statewide competition for girls was held in 1974 here in Bakersfield. We are pleased that this year's State Meet is again being held at the Bakersfield Stadium where state and national championships have been held in an excellent facility with the expertise of the Bakersfield area track officials.

The quality of performances in the State Track Meet are perhaps best attested by comparing the State CIF Track Meet Championship record with the national record in each of the events. Both the state and national records are listed in the program on each of the event pages. Many of the national records are held by California high school students. Bakersfield's track and field facilities are excellent and it is likely that new state and national records will be set at the State CIF Meet this year.

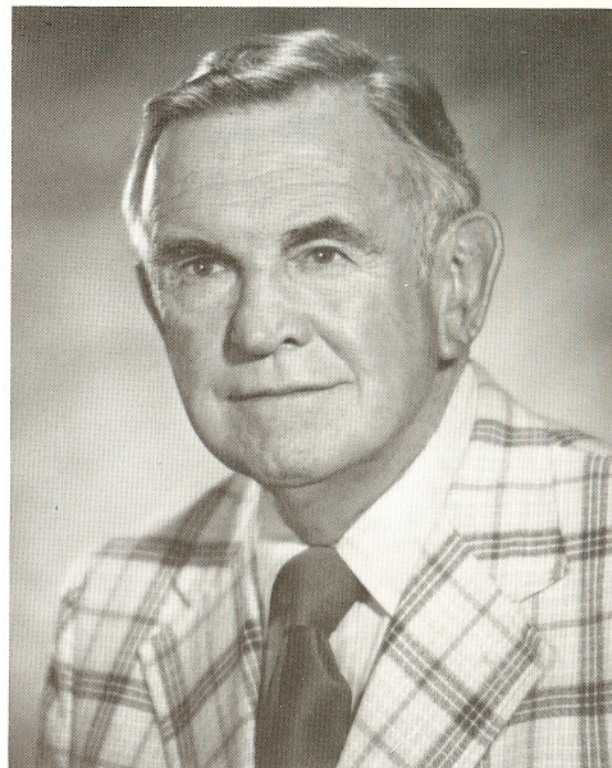

Honorary Referee for 1978

Norman MacDonald



Norman MacDonald has served high school athletics as a coach, athletic director, vice-principal, principal, and CIF administrator for forty-five years. He participated in football, baseball, and track during his high school and/or college years. He received his A.B. degree from Occidental College in 1932 and later did graduate work at Occidental and at the University of Southern California.

His teaching career began in 1933 at Fowler High School where he remained for five years as head coach for football and baseball, athletic director, and math and physical education teacher.

In 1938 he went to Fresno High School as line coach of football, swimming coach, and teacher of biology and physiology, serving there until 1943 when he entered the U.S. Navy for three years of sea duty during World War II.

In 1946 he returned to Fresno and began a long tenure at Edison High School, starting as line coach in football, athletic director and vice principal. From 1948 to 1953 his sole duty there was as vice principal, and then as principal from 1953 to 1964.

During MacDonald's first three years as principal at Edison he was a League President and a member of the CIF Central Section Executive Board. In 1957 he became the CIF Central Section President and a member of the State Federated Council, serving until 1961. In 1962 he began a three-year term as President of the State CIF Federated Council.

After his eighteen years at Edison he became the Director of Athletics and Physical Education for the Fresno Unified School District and served in that capacity until he retired from Fresno Unified in 1969 when he assumed his current position as Executive Secretary and Section Commissioner for the CIF Central Section.

During the years he has always been a promoter of the West Coast Relays and in 1976 and 1977 served as referee of the high school section of that meet.

We are pleased to honor Norman MacDonald by naming him honorary referee of the 1978 State CIF Championship Track and Field Meet, for his long service to boys and girls interscholastic athletics.

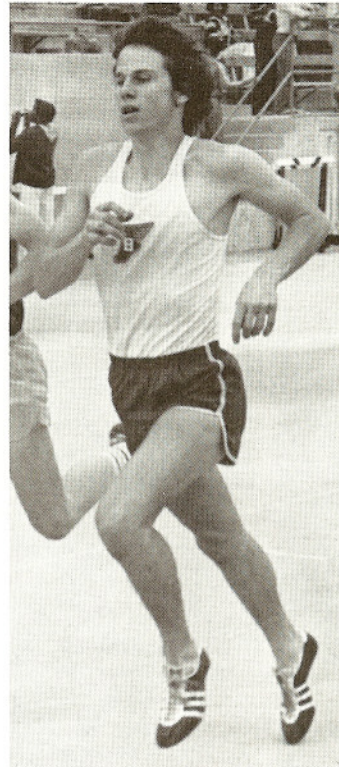

California's 14 CIF Sections Honor Coaches

Annually, each high school section selects a man or woman for honors, who has contributed notably to the sport of track and field



ART DALZELL of Bakersfield High School has been involved in track since his high school days in Kansas where he was the state 880 yard record holder, and later at Kansas University where he received All-American honors and was a member of a National Championship Cross-country team.

After coaching several years in Kansas, Art migrated in California where for the last 11 years as head coach at Bakersfield High School his teams have compiled a dual meet record of 72 wins and 6 losses, and has won S.Y.L. and 3 San Joaquin Valley Championships.

His well coached teams are always highly competitive to which Art gives credit to the assistant coaches Jim Cowles, Vernal Anderson, Jim Coons and Pat Preston.



DOUG SMITH, Arcadia High School, CIF-Southern Section. Doug has been at Arcadia High School for sixteen years coaching both track and football, thirteen years as head mens track coach and since 1974 leading the women's program as well. During his tenure, Arcadia track teams, both men and women on all levels, have compiled a won/loss record of 366-46-2 in dual meet competition. In that time his teams have also won twenty league championships and nine invitationals. His women were CIF-SS champions in 1976.

As a final tribute Coach Smith was selected this year as California Track Coach of the Year by the California Coaches Association.



MIKE MUIRHEAD, Helix H.S., San Diego. Mike Muirhead has compiled an enviable record during his sixteen years as head varsity coach in cross country and track and field at Helix H.S. His track and field teams have won eight league championships while three of his cross country teams have finished on top. At the Section level, Mike's athletes have accounted for one team championship in track and field, three championships in cross country, and three runner-up spots. His Helix H.S. coaching career shows a remarkable 95-17 dual meet record in track and field. Coach Muirhead possesses a wide range of expertise - he has sent athletes to the State Meet in ten separate events.

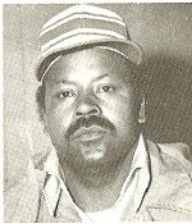


JOHN GILLEY, Sac-Joaquin Section, a graduate of Sacramento State University. Track Coach at Vacaville High School for the past 13 years, with a record of 65 and 26, and his teams have won numerous invitations throughout northern California. The most outstanding of many fine athletes was Ray Burton, a 201-6 with the discus and state champ. Ray is also the all time record holder for the collegiate discus while in high school, 177-4.



BOB WALL graduated from Stanford University in 1966 with an A.B. and M.A. He did his first coaching at Gunn High School in Palo Alto now is at Lassen High School. During the past 12 years he has coached track and cross-country, both boys and girls. His teams have compiled a record of 7 Section Cross-Country Championships, 7 League Track Championships and 3 Section Track Championships.

He has coached 3 individual All-Americans in the past three years and two National Champions, Steve Montgomery, 1976 Shot Put and Pam Allen, 1975 Cross Country. Two athletes currently holding CIF State Track Meet Records, Steve Montgomery, Shot Put and Karen Stampfli, Discus.



EARL LOVE, Oakland High School. In ten years of coaching Track and Field at Oakland High Love's teams have won two outright O.A.L. championships; tie for one; lost one by one point, and finished second twice. His jumpers have dominated O.A.L. and relay competition throughout the state with the likes of Don Bryson, 50'2", Golden West and U.S.C.; Dan Jackson, 50'11", Golden West and U.S.C.; Allen Goodlow, 50'5", U.C. Northridge and Kurt Durham 25'1", Horizontal Jump and 50' Triple Jump. Durhams 25'1" was the best jump in the nation in 1977. Scholastic All-American and first place finishers in the State meet. His team-mate Bill Hice, 7'1/4" High Jumper, was also Scholastic All-American 2nd place finisher in the State and first place finisher 1977 Golden West.



KENNETH J.W. STUMPF, Washington High School. Graduated from Washington High School in 1962 and attended California State University at Pomona. He participated in track and football in high school and in college where he specialized in the weight events in track. Was the league Champ in the Shot Put in 1962 in Los Angeles' tough Southern League. In 1972 he began coaching at his alma mater—both Track and Football. His teams have compiled a record of 96-61-2 with 1 league championship in the Cee classification and in 1977 league and city championships in the Bee class. Some of the young athletes who have been through Washington's Track Program under Ken Stumpf are: James Lofton (Stanford), Eric McNeal (UCLA), Leonard Ledet (CSLB), and Jodi Anderson (CSN).

JIM UNDERHILL North Coast Section Boys Honor Coach, Piner High School (Santa Rosa), is one of the most successful coaches of high school distance runners in Northern California. His cross country teams at Tennyson (Hayward) High School won four straight championships while posting an outstanding 60-0 record. He has coached championship North Coast Section cross country teams at Piner and Tennyson.

His Piner track teams have won six Sonoma County League championships, including the last four straight. He has served on the Section Track Committee for many years and has directed numerous Section championship events.

Jim is retiring from coaching track this year. He states: "I've enjoyed working with athletes."



SANDY WILLIAMS. This popular coach has been 10 years at Royal High School. She has a dual meet record of 76-24, 5 league championships, 4 individual champions and coached in 1975 CIF-SS team champions. Sandy is an energetic and hardworking coach who has worked with XCountry and track in AAU - was meet director of 1969 AAU Nat. Cross-Country Championships; meet director of 1973 and 1975 AAU Junior National Track Championships. She traveled as team leader with 1969 Pan-Pacific team to Japan; in 1974 to the USA-Russia dual meet in Moscow; and in 1976 with the Junior National Team on a European tour.

She was the Meet Director of Girls AAAA Divisional Finals and Championships in 1977, CIF-SS.



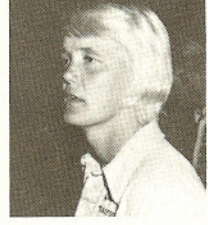
BETTY BENNETT, Madison H.S., San Diego. One of San Diego Section's most outstanding girls' track and field coaches is Betty Bennett of Madison H.S. Over her 19-year coaching career in the AAU and at Madison and Mission Bay High Schools, she has been the mentor of many quality athletes, including Kathy Devine, state record-breaker in the girls' shot put, and of nationally ranked javelin throwers RaNae Bair Seaman (American record-holder in the 1964 and 1968 Olympics), Roberta Brown (1972 Olympics), and Karen Smith. An extremely hard worker, Betty has demonstrated a professional dedication to the continued development of the girls' track and field program.



ALICE SUMMERS graduated from Cal State University, Sacramento in 1969. She received her Masters in 1974. Alice began teaching in the Yuba City Unified School District in 1970. She coached the Girls Track Team from 1975 to 1977. During that time, they won league championships in 1975 and 1976. They were section champions in 1976. Alice has had several girls qualify and go to the State Track meets and do fairly well. Alice was also league rep for the Delta League in 1977.

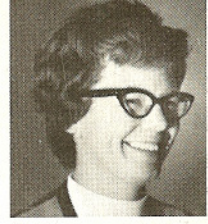

That was Yvonne Boone who has gone on to run on various track teams - competing now for the College of Alameda.

Karin came to Fremont after spending the first two years after her graduation from San Francisco State as a long term substitute. She not only has successfully coached the Track team but has coached winning teams in Varsity Volleyball and J.V. Basketball. In her spare time, Karin LOVES to play Field Hockey and competes every Sunday during the season.



PAT NORDELL graduated from the University of Arizona in 1958 with a B.S. and later got her M.S. from California State University of Los Angeles 1964. She did her first teaching at Coachella Valley High School and is now at Westchester High School in Los Angeles. Her track teams have been league champions for the past four years and are currently undefeated in 1978. Her team took first in the city in 1977. Her teams have been in the top six in the state the past three years. Pat has coached all girl's sports plus boys tennis. She is an outstanding contributor to athletics in California.
