THE CENTRAL COAST SECTION OF THE CALIFORNIA INTERSCHOLASTIC FEDERATION BELIEVES IN GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP

It is expected that all participants and coaches will perform with great enthusiasm in CCS Championship competition. These events should capture the emotions of participants, fans and coaches.

Performance in the highly charged emotional climate of playoffs is another step in the educational process for our student-athletes. We would not want it any other way. However it is essential that such competition be completely within the bounds of GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP. We insist upon that!

WEBSTER DEFINES SPORTSMANSHIP AS:

**"CONDUCT BECOMING TO A SPORTSMAN, A PERSON WHO IS FAIR, GENEROUS,
A GOOD LOSER AND A GRACEFUL WINNER."**

As the coordinating body for all interscholastic athletic activity conducted within the Section, the Board establishes the following policy concerning Sportsmanship at all athletic events among member schools.

- (1) Players are expected to conduct themselves in a manner which shall bring credit to themselves, their schools, communities, coaches and families. They shall refrain from all conduct which tends to degrade, bait, intimidate, or otherwise discredit their opponent, officials, or inter-scholastic athletics.
- (2) Coaches are expected to maintain decorum consistent with the educational values of interscholastic athletics. By personal example, coaches are expected to demonstrate their awareness of these values by showing restraint and composure in the emotional climate of an athletic contest and to insist that players in their charge conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike manner.
- (3) Responsible member school personnel are expected to instruct and supervise the conduct of student spirit leaders, rooting sections, bands, and other student groups in order to achieve an atmosphere consistent with good sportsmanship. School administrators are expected to control or cause to be controlled spectators in such a manner that all athletic contests are conducted in an atmosphere which is consistent with the educational values of inter-scholastic athletics.
- (4) Flagrant instances of unsportsmanlike behavior on the part of players, coaches, and/or fans should be reported by the school principal(s) to the Board of Managers through the Section Commissioner, together with a description of action taken by member schools.
- (5) No artificial noise-makers are allowed at any CCS Playoff Contests.

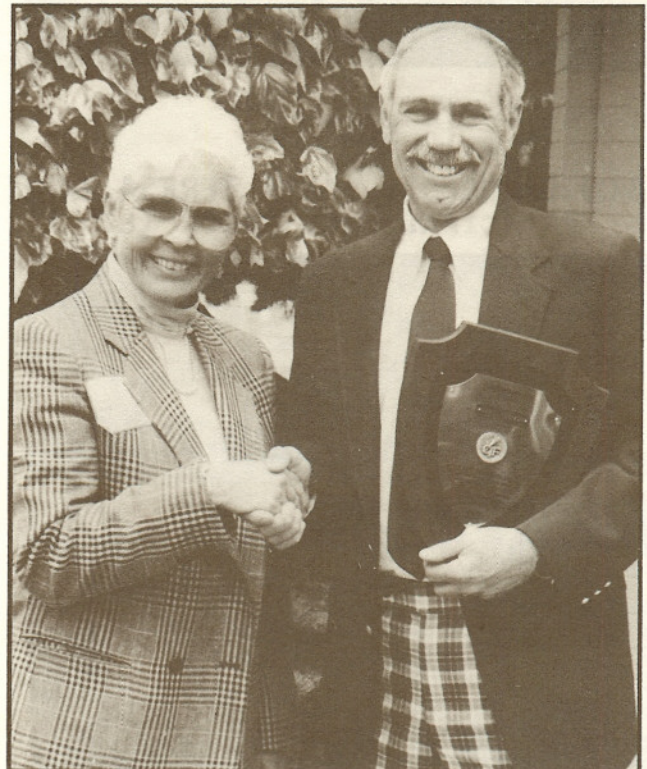
