IV. PROPOSED MAJOR FORMAT CHANGES

PROPOSAL #1 (TCAL Recommendation):

The number of qualifiers to the Section Finals should be equal to the number of lanes available at the Finals venue. The number of qualifiers in the Field events should increase accordingly as well. For example: If the venue for the Track & Field Finals has nine (9) lanes available, then there would be nine (9) qualifiers for each event coming out of the Semi's. (approved by a vote of 10-0-0)

- <u>Rationale</u>: If the Finals venue has the capacity to accommodate more qualifiers, why not give more kids the chance to be included.
- *<u>Financial impact</u>:* With the potential for more participants in the Finals, there is also potential for an increase of Play-off Fees for some schools/Leagues, as they are charged by the number of participants per event. The current charge is \$5 per participant per event.

There would be a minimal increase in the income by this proposal, due to the potential of increased spectators (parents, etc.) watching more qualifiers.
